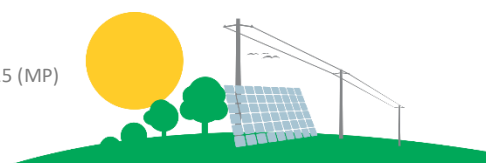

JAVA 13 dead after old munitions explode

At least 13 people were killed in an explosion during a disposal of expired military ammunition in West Java Antara News has reported citing the Indonesian Defence Forces. The blast took place on Monday. Those who died include four military officers, who were part of the operation to dispose expired ammunition in Sagara village in West Java's Garut district.

LONDON Fire at UK PM's private house, 1 held

British police said Tuesday that they have arrested a man on suspicion of arson with intent to endanger life over a fire at the London house where UK Prime Minister Keir Starmer lived before he was elected to lead the country. The 21-year-old was arrested early Tuesday over three fire incidents. Starmer doesn't currently live in his private house. Since taking office in July, Starmer has lived with his family in the prime minister's official Downing Street residence.

Car accident in Pennsylvania leaves 2 Indian students dead

Two Indian students have been killed in an accident in Pennsylvania after their car crashed into a tree and struck a bridge, officials said.

Another passenger in the front seat of the vehicle was injured in the accident early Saturday morning and rushed to a local hospital, they said.

"Deeply saddened to learn about the unfortunate road accident in which two Indian students from Cleveland State University, Manav Patel (20) and Saurav Prabhakar (23) lost their lives," the Consulate General of India in New York said in a post on X Monday.

The consulate added, "Our thoughts and prayers are with their families during this difficult time. The Consulate is in touch with the families and has assured them of all possible assistance."

According to a report in Lancasteronline.com, the young students were killed Saturday in a single-vehicle crash at 7 am on the Pennsylvania Turnpike in Brecknock Township.

According to the Lancaster county coroner's office and Pennsylvania state police, Patel and Prabhakar died after their vehicle crashed into a tree and struck a bridge. It added that Prabhakar was driving the vehicle.

Police say both men died at the scene from multiple traumatic injuries. Both deaths were ruled accidental.

Germany bans far-right 'Reich citizen' group, arrests 4 leaders

The German government has banned the largest "Reich citizen" group, an extremist far-right organisation that calls itself the "Kingdom of Germany" and seeks to undermine the country's democratic order. Four of its leaders were arrested. Since early Tuesday morning, hundreds of security forces in several states have been searching the association's properties and the homes of leading members.

"The members of this association have created a "counter-state" in our country and built up economic criminal structures," Interior Minister Alexander Dobrindt said, adding that the members of the group underpinned their supposed claim to power with antisemitic conspiracy narratives.

US, Saudi ink \$142bn arms deal

U.S. President Donald Trump signed a strategic economic agreement with Saudi Arabia on Tuesday as the oil power rolled out the red carpet for him at the start of a tour of Gulf states aimed at drumming up trillions of dollars in investments.

Trump punched the air as he emerged from Air Force One to be greeted by Prince Mohammed bin Salman, who later signed an agreement with the president which Saudi state television said covered energy, defence, mining and other areas.

The White House said Saudi Arabia was set to invest \$600 billion in the United States, including the largest defence sales agreement between the allies, worth nearly \$142 billion.

"I really believe we like each other a lot," Trump said during a meeting in Riyadh with the crown prince, Saudi Arabia's de facto ruler.

Trump, who is accompanied by a host of U.S. business leaders including billionaire Elon Musk, will go on from Riyadh to Qatar on Wednesday and the United Arab Emirates on Thursday.



He has not scheduled a stop in Israel, a decision that has raised questions about where the close ally stands in Washington's priorities, and the focus of the trip is on investment rather than security matters in the Middle East.

"While energy remains a cornerstone of our relationship, the investments and business opportunities in the kingdom have expanded and multiplied many, many times over," Saudi Investment Minister Khalid al-Falih said as he opened the forum.

"As a result ... when Saudis and Americans join forces

very good things happen, more often than not great things happen when those joint ventures happen," he said before Trump's arrival.

In a meeting at the Royal Court, Trump called the Saudi crown prince a friend and said they have a good relationship, according to a pool report from the Wall Street Journal. Trump recalled travelling to the kingdom in 2017 and said Saudi investment would help create jobs in the U.S.

He said jokingly that a \$600-billion investment pledge by Saudi Arabia could be \$1 trillion, repeating a figure he has

cited before as he seeks investment from an important strategic partner.

Riyadh hosted a Saudi-US investment forum as Trump visited, with attendees including Larry Fink, the CEO of asset management firm BlackRock, Stephen A. Schwartzman, CEO of asset manager Blackstone, and Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent.

Musk chatted briefly with both Trump and the crown prince, who is otherwise known as MbS, during a palace reception for the U.S. president. And joining Trump for a lunch with MbS were top U.S. busi-

Storm in a coffee cup

During a meeting with Saudi Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman, US President Donald Trump refused to drink the offered cup of coffee, leaving it on the table while continuing his conversation. Footage from the meeting — appearing to show Trump refusing coffee twice — sparked criticism on Saudi social media, with some calling it an insult. Hours later, Saudi media released new footage showing Trump eventually taking a sip. Trump has publicly stated in the past that he avoids alcohol, cigarettes, and even coffee — habits influenced by the death of his older brother who struggled with alcoholism.

Come to Türkiye for Ukraine peace talks: Zelenskyy to Trump

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy urged US President Donald Trump to find an opportunity to visit Türkiye as the country has been proposed as the site for discussions between Russia and Ukraine.

In a video message, the Ukrainian President said that he is ready to visit Türkiye for the talks. Noting that Ukraine supports diplomacy, he hoped for the US President to support the meeting and find an opportunity to attend it.

"Ukraine has always supported diplomacy. I am ready to come to Türkiye. Unfortunately, the world still has not received a clear response from Russia to the numerous proposals for a ceasefire." "Russian shelling and assaults continue. Moscow has remained silent all day regarding the proposal for a direct meeting. A very strange silence. One way or another, Russia will have to end this war -- and the sooner, the better. There is no sense in continuing the killing." "President Erdogan has expressed full readiness to host the meeting. It is important that President Trump fully supports the meeting, and we would like him to find an opportunity to come to Türkiye."

Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan held a phone conversation with his Ukrainian counterpart Volodymyr Zelenskyy, reiterating Türkiye's commitment to facilitating peace negotiations between Russia and Ukraine, according to a statement by Erdogan's office.

Erdogan emphasised that a comprehensive ceasefire is essential to create the proper environment for initiating talks and urged all parties to seize the current window of opportunity for a diplomatic dialogue aimed at ending the conflict.

mir Putin on Sunday called for direct talks with Ukraine in Istanbul, saying it should start without delay, as early as May 15. In a televised address shared by the Russian Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Putin emphasised that the talks should take place "without any preconditions" and that Türkiye, under President Recep Tayyip Erdogan, should once again serve as the host.

After tariff truce, Beijing lifts curbs on Boeing delivery

Beijing has lifted its ban on the delivery of Boeing aircraft, in a significant step toward cooling off the US-China tariff war.

It marks a significant step in the cooling of the tariff war between the United States and China. The move comes after the two nations reached an agreement to temporarily reduce steep tariffs during a 90-day negotiation period. Sources familiar with the matter told Bloomberg that Chinese officials informed domestic airlines and government agencies this week



that they can now resume taking delivery of U.S.-made aircraft. This development follows a period in which Boeing faced difficulties in delivering planes to China, including the repatriation of at least three jets from Boeing's delivery centre in China back to the United States last month, Reuters reported. The delivery ban had been linked to the trade tensions

between the world's two largest economies. Bloomberg previously reported that Boeing had been subject to a de facto import ban from China as part of the ongoing trade dispute. However, Beijing has

not provided a formal explanation for halting Boeing deliveries, and senior industry sources told Reuters they were unaware of any official directives against accepting the planes.
