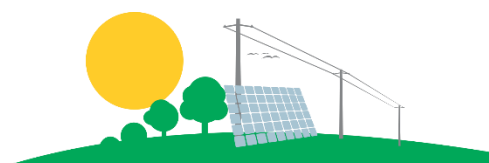

China warns Papua New Guinea over Oz defence pact

China has cautioned Papua New Guinea (PNG) against “undermining” its interests and sovereignty by entering into a new mutual defence agreement with Australia, a deal widely viewed as a counter to Beijing’s growing influence in the Pacific.

Australia and Papua New Guinea this week agreed on the text of the pact, which commits both nations to defending each other from armed attacks.

Asked about the development, a spokesperson for Beijing’s embassy in Port Moresby said China respected Papua New Guinea’s right to strike deals with other countries. However, they stressed that such an agreement should not be “exclusive,” nor prevent PNG from cooperating with other partners.

“It should also refrain from targeting any third party or undermining its legitimate rights and interests,” the spokesperson warned, urging PNG to continue “mutually beneficial coop” with China.

Xi to Trump: Open to TikTok negotiations

Chinese President Xi Jinping told President Donald Trump that Washington should stop imposing unilateral tariffs but that it welcomes negotiations over TikTok, according to a Chinese state media summary of the leaders’ call on Friday.

The official readout described the first call in three months between the two men as positive and constructive.

But it left open a question about whether the two sides had reached an agreement over the fate of short-video app TikTok.

“On TikTok, Xi said China’s position is clear: the Chinese government respects corporate will and welcomes companies to conduct business negotiations on the basis of market rules to reach a solution consistent with Chinese laws and regulations and a



US HALTS \$400MN MILITARY AID PACKAGE TO TAIWAN

US President Donald Trump has declined to give approval for USD 400 million of military aid to Taiwan because he is seeking to negotiate a trade deal with China, The Washington Post reported citing sources. Trump is also striving for a summit deal with his Chinese counterpart Xi Jinping, as per an exclusive report of the US newspaper on Thursday. The Trump administration is generally seeking to soften relations with Beijing, the Post noted.

balance of interests,” according to the meeting summary in Xinhua.

Trump said on Friday that he and Xi Jinping made progress on a TikTok deal and

agreed to a face-to-face meeting as soon as next month in South Korea and he will travel to China early next year.

“We made progress on many very important issues including Trade, Fentanyl, the need to bring the War between Russia and Ukraine to an end, and the approval of the TikTok Deal,” Trump wrote on social media.

Trump said that the two leaders would meet at the APEC summit in South Korea that begins next month and that he would go to China early next year. He also said Xi would come to the US at a later date.

“The call was a very good one, we will be speaking again by phone, appreciate the TikTok approval, and both look forward to meeting at APEC!” Trump wrote.

The statement did not spell out the terms of an agreement between the leaders on TikTok. The White House did not immediately comment.

Taliban free British couple held in Af for seven months

The Taliban released on Friday a British couple held in Afghanistan for more than seven months on undisclosed charges, an official said, likely part of a wider effort to get their government recognised internationally years after taking power.

The case of Peter and Barbie Reynolds, aged 80 and 75, underlined the concerns of the West over the actions of the Taliban since they overthrew the country’s US-backed government in a 2021 lightning offensive. The Reynolds had lived in Afghanistan for 18 years and run an education and training organisation in the country’s central province of Bamian, choosing to remain in the country after the Taliban seized power.

Qatar, an energy-rich nation on the Arabian Peninsula that mediated talks between the US and the Taliban before the American withdrawal, helped in releasing the Reynolds. The couple left Afghanistan on Friday, a diplomat said. The diplomat spoke on condition of anonymity to discuss the sensi-

tive negotiations in the case. “God is good, as they say in Afghanistan,” Barbie Reynolds said after she arrived at Kabul International Airport to fly out of the country.

The Reynolds’ family members in the United Kingdom repeatedly called for the couple’s release, saying they were being mistreated and held on undisclosed charges. While the Taliban rejected the abuse allegations, they have never explained what prompted their detention.

A spokesperson at the Taliban government’s Foreign Ministry, Abdul Qahar Balkhi, said the couple “violated Afghan law” and were released from prison on Friday after a court hearing, according to a statement he

posted on X. His statement did not say what law the couple were alleged to have broken.

Balkhi thanked Qatar for its “sincere efforts and mediation” regarding the couple who, he said, were handed over to Richard Lindsay, the UK’s special envoy for Afghanistan.

British Prime Minister Keir Starmer welcomed the couple’s release, saying he knew “this long-awaited news will come as a huge relief to them and their family.”

“I want to pay tribute to the vital role played by Qatar, including the emir, His Highness Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad al Thani, in securing their freedom,” Starmer said in a statement.

CAIRO 43 killed in Sudan mosque drone strike

A Sudanese paramilitary group reportedly killed 43 civilians while praying inside a mosque on early Friday in the besieged city of El Fasher, the capital of North Darfur, said a local medical group. The Sudan Doctors Network said on Friday on X that Muslim worshippers, including older people and children, were killed in a drone strike launched by the Rapid Support Forces, calling it a “heinous crime” against unarmed civilians that showed the group’s “blatant disregard for humanitarian and religious values and international law.”

MOSCOW Quake shakes Russia’s far east region

A powerful 7.8 magnitude earthquake has struck near the east coast of Russia’s Kamchatka region, the US Geological Survey said. There were no immediate reports of damage. The quake’s epicentre was 127 km east of Petropavlovsk-Kamchatsky and it struck at 6:58 am on Friday local time, as per USGS. It had a depth of 19.5 km. The Pacific Tsunami Warning System briefly issued a tsunami threat but later lifted it. The initial quake was followed by a series of aftershocks of up to magnitude 5.8.

Nepal observes Constitution Day, PM calls for dialogue for finding solutions

Nepal Prime Minister Sushila Karki on Friday said the protection and successful implementation of the Constitution adopted 10 years ago is the responsibility of all Nepalis, asserting that democracy is a system of dialogue and finding solutions.

Karki was speaking at the main event organised here in view of the Constitution Day, also celebrated as the National Day across Nepal. However, unlike in the past, the celebrations this year are scaled down as the country mourns the death of 72 people in the violent protests by Gen Z that led to

regime change last week. Nepal’s Constituent Assembly delivered the Constitution on Asoj 3, 2072 Bikram Samvat, as per the country’s national calendar, or September 20, 2015,

“Listening to the voice of the people is the soul of democracy,” Karki, Nepal’s first woman prime minister, said.

Govt didn’t give shootout order during stir: Oli

Nepal’s deposed prime minister KP Sharma Oli has denied that his government gave the shootout order during the ‘Gen Z’ protests on the first day of the agitation on September 8 that killed at least 19 people.

The Communist Party of Nepal (Unified Marxist-Leninist) chairman instead blamed the infiltrators for the tragedy. “The government didn’t order to shoot at the demonstrators,” Oli claimed.

Faced racial hatred, claimed Indian techie shot dead by US cops

A 30-year-old man from Telangana, who died after being shot by the police in the US when they found him stabbing a roommate during an altercation, had claimed that he was a victim of “racial hatred and discrimination”.

Mohammed Nizamuddin from Mahabubnagar district was shot by officers of the Santa Clara Police Department when they arrived at the scene of the altercation on September 3.

Before the incident, Nizamuddin wrote on social media that he was a “victim of racial hatred, racial discrimination, racial harassment, torture, wage fraud, wrongful termination and obstruction of Justice”.

“Today I decided to raise my voice against all odds... Oppression of corporate tyrants must end, and everyone involved in it must be punished severely,” he wrote.

Nizamuddin also posted in the message that he faced a lot of hostility, an unacceptable environment, racial discrimination, racial harassment and salary fraud where he worked.

“They altogether wrongfully terminated my employment. It did not end there. They continued their harassment, discrimination and intimidating behaviour by the help of a racist detective and team,” he had alleged.

Lately, the situation deteriorated. He claimed that his food was poisoned, and he was being evicted from his residence for fighting against “unjust”.



Citing information received from a friend of his son, Nizamuddin’s father, Mohammed Hasnuddin, said in Hyderabad on Thursday that it is unclear what exactly happened. Hasnuddin said his son was working as a software professional in the US after completing his MS there. Giving details of the incident, the Santa Clara Police Department said that on September 3, at approximately 6.18 am, its officers responded to a residence in Santa Clara regarding a report of a stabbing. The caller stated that the suspect had stabbed one victim in the residence. When officers arrived, they encountered Nizamuddin, who was shot by an officer, police said.

US vetoes UNSC resolution on immediate Gaza ceasefire

The United States once again vetoed a UN Security Council resolution on Thursday that had demanded an immediate and permanent ceasefire in Gaza and the release of hostages, saying that the effort did not go far enough in condemning Hamas.

The 14 other members of the United Nations’ most powerful body voted in favour of the resolution, which described the humanitarian situation in Gaza as “catastrophic” and called on Israel to lift all restrictions on the delivery of aid to the 2.1 million Palestinians in the territory.

“US opposition to this resolution will come as no surprise,” Morgan Ortogus, a senior US policy adviser, said before the vote.

EU chief urges bloc members to sanction Russia’s LNG exports

The European Union should slap new sanctions on Russia’s exports of liquefied natural gas, its shadow fleet of aging oil tankers and major energy companies over its war on Ukraine, European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen said on Friday.

“It is time to turn off the tap” on LNG, von der Leyen said in a video statement outlining her commission’s new sanctions proposals. They must be endorsed by the 27 EU countries before they can enter

force.

“I now call on member states to quickly endorse these new sanctions. We want Russia to leave the battlefield and come to the negotiation table, and this is the way to give peace a real chance,” she said.

The bloc has already agreed on 18 packages of sanctions against Russia, but getting final agreement on who and what to target can take weeks.

More than 2,500 “entities” including banks, ministries, energy companies and officials have already been hit.

The officials include Presi-

dent Vladimir Putin and his associates, scores of Russian lawmakers and several oligarchs. Travel bans and asset freezes are the most common measures.

Moscow open to compromise with Ukraine: Lavrov

Russia is ready to reach a compromise with Ukraine provided its core interests are safeguarded, Russian Foreign Minister Sergey Lavrov said. Lavrov noted that direct talks between Moscow and Kiev resumed in May in Istanbul after several years, but no breakthrough was achieved.

Now, Russian jets violate Estonia airspace

Tallinn: Estonia summoned a Russian diplomat to protest after three Russian fighter aircraft entered its airspace without permission on Friday and stayed there for 12 minutes, the Foreign Ministry said.

Foreign Minister Margus Tsakhna said that Russia had already violated Estonian airspace four times this year “but today’s incursion, involving three fighter aircraft entering our airspace, is unprecedentedly brazen.”

His ministry said that the incursion took place over the Gulf of Finland and three Russian MIG-31 fighters were involved.

More US TV networks in Trump crosshairs

US President Donald Trump has suggested that TV networks which cover him “negatively” could be punished by the government after his celebration of ABC suspending late-night host Jimmy Kimmel.

On Air Force One, the president spoke to reporters on Thursday on his flight back to the US from his state visit to the UK. He said major US networks were “97% against me”, though he did not offer evidence to prove this figure or detail how this conclusion was evaluated. He said he read the statistic “someplace”, The Guardian reported.

“Again, 97% negative, and yet I won easily. I won all seven swing states,” Trump said. “They give me only bad press. I mean they’re getting a licence. I would think maybe their licences should be taken away.”

His claim that US TV networks were to be licenced by the



government to operate is, however, incorrect. While local TV

stations do require a licence from the Federal Communica-

tions Commission, the FCC says clearly on its website that it does “not licence TV or radio networks (such as CBS, NBC, ABC or Fox)”.

Trump supported ABC’s decision to suspend Jimmy Kimmel’s late-night show, saying that the comedian was “not a talented person” who “had very bad ratings”. According to Nielsen ratings as reported by LateNight,

although Stephen Colbert’s Late Show leads the time slot in total viewers with 2.42 million, Kimmel’s show averaged 1.77 million viewers in the second quarter of 2025 and edged out Colbert in the key 18-49 demographic. However, there was an 11% drop-off in his show’s viewership the last month. Kimmel also has over 20 million subscribers on YouTube.
